Eligible entrants

Entry to the Promotion is open to year 6 students in Southern Highlands schools, NSW who fulfil the method of entry requirements.

Details of prizes

The best entry/entries as determined by the judges will be deemed the prize winner(s) and will win:

All entries are judged individually on their merit. Winners (1x grand prize, 1x gold prize, 1x silver, and 3x bronze) will receive a certificate of recognition and a digital application of their artwork on a hanging banner within the arcade from January - April 2027 (exact dates TBA). Grand prize winner will have artwork on banner PLUS a chalk art session (January date TBC) with a professional Chalk Artist (who has NSW Working with Children Clearance). Winners are chosen at a judge's decision based on skill or originality.

Prior to participation in any travel or event prize, any winner and participant may be required to sign an indemnity and waiver of liability in favour of the Promoter and all involved parties. If a participant is a minor, the indemnity and waiver of liability must be signed by the participant's parent/guardian.

Method of entry

To enter, the principal or an appointed school representative of a participating primary school in Wingecarribee Shire must, during the promotional period, complete the entry form and then submit in person the school's selected Year 6 winning artwork to Springett's Arcade Management before the close of the promotional period.

Maximum number of entries

One artwork entry per Wingecarribee grade 6 primary school.

Determination of winners

The judging will be performed by an independent panel of artistic judges appointed by the Promoter.

This is a competition based on skill and chance plays no part in determining the winner.
